Funding for fire companies, EMS as well as lack of volunteers seem to be in the news every day. It is a national problem with no solution in sight. Contributions from the various townships we serve only cover approximately 30% of our yearly operating budget.

Our fundraisers and donations are our main source of funding for the fire company. We are always looking for additional fundraising ideas and we've changed our fundraisers the last few years to include cash parties, wing nights, bagged ice sales, gun raffle, Comedy Night, and fish fries during Lent which are serving an average of 280 meals each week. Our fundraisers take a lot of hours for our members, and we appreciate the support we receive so that we can continue to serve the community we serve. If you have a fundraising idea, please don't hesitate to contact a member, and give them an idea.

The price of equipment, tools, gear, etc. is skyrocketing. To help put it in perspective, our 2017 Pierce Engine Rescue unit was \$609,000. To purchase that same unit today it would cost us \$1.2 million and would require a 4 year lead time until we actually received the unit.

We applied for several grants over the last year and are the recipients of a state fire commissioner's grant of over \$13,000 for debt reduction of our 2017 Engine/Rescue unit. We also received a FEMA grant to purchase a rope rescue kit, and a winch for the front of our Brush Truck.

We are always looking for volunteers to help with responding to calls, help at fundraisers etc.

We are very, grateful for all the support the community gives us through donations and support of our events. From all of us at Warriors Mark-Franklin Fire Company, THANK YOU for your support.

Gun Raffle: Our 5th annual Gun Raffle was held on July 20, 2024. With 55 prizes on the ticket and additional guns raffled off that day it was our largest raffle to date. Plans are underway for next year to make it even bigger and better. After all income and expenses were counted we made over \$38,000 for the fire company. Thank you for your support!

ICE—8 lb. bag \$1.00 Last year we sold almost 12,000 bags of ice and are on pace to surpass that total this year. We have 2 freezers for ice outside. We do ask if you need a large quantity of 20 bags or more for a special event to call the firehall as far in advance as possible and leave a message so we can make sure we have what you need. This is a great fundraiser for the Fire Company and we greatly appreciate the communities support.
