ACT 537 WASTEWATER FACILITY PLAN  
PUBLIC MEETING AND PUBLIC COMMENT**

Warriors Mark Township will be considering a new Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan for adoption. The intent of this plan is to address the present and future sewage disposal needs of the Township.

The plan proposes the continuation of an on-lot wastewater system management program to serve the entire Township. Under the management program, owners of on-lot systems are required to pump the system no less than once every three years and, at the time of pumping, arrange for an inspection of the system by the Township's sewage enforcement officer (SEO). Systems that have been identified as malfunctioning by the SEO will require appropriate repair or replacement at the expense of the property owner. Any such repairs or replacements will require a permit from the SEO or the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). The construction and management of a public system was considered but rejected for environmental and economic reasons detailed within the plan.

The Warriors Mark Township Supervisors invite residents and interested parties to a public forum presenting the plan on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. in the Warriors Mark Fire Hall located at 4571 Fire House Road, Warriors Mark, PA. The proposed Act 537 Plan will then be available for public comment for a 30-day period following the meeting.
